2	Chinese Garden proposed by Manawatu Chinese Association	Park Central – at or near the Duck Pond	TBA at 13 August 2018 Committee Meeting (Dr Allan Young currently overseas). No specific Masterplan funding allocated yet.	In principle support.
3	18 hole Mini-Golf proposed by Central Districts Lions	Play Zone – opposite twin turfs by fort playground	Likely cost is confidential.  \$25k allocated in Masterplan for drainage works.  Planned in Year 1: 2018/19.	Supported subject to final design refinements – an exciting addition to the playground.
4	Paul Dibble Sculpture proposed by Central Energy Trust Wildbase Recovery Trust	Park Central – middle of Duck Pond Island	Likely cost is confidential.  No funding allocation.  Planned in Year 1: 2018/19.	Supported – the sculpture will be an outstanding feature in this location.
