# CAPITAL WORKS DASHBOARD SUMMARY FY 19/20

## CATALYST PROGRAMMES

- Wastewater BPO Project BPO short list options confirmed, consultation and the community engagement on these options has been completed.
- Infrastructure for Residential Growth Assessment work to support a global stormwater consent for Whakarongo completed. Pressure sewer policy, bylaw, and standards adopted in time to guide City West plan change application.
- City-Wide Stormwater Management Capital renewal and improvement programmes of work 100% complete, Ashhurst stormwater model extension completed.
- City Wide Water Supply, Source and Storage Development - Papaioea Bore 3 and UV disinfection system completed and commissioned. Turitea WTP Initial seismic assessment and Turitea dams detailed seismic assessment complete. Railway Road bore development 90% complete with commissioning scheduled for late 2020.
- CET Arena Arena Artificial Pitch completed Aug 2019. Major Arena Redevelopment underway. including relocation of the Speedway Pits, upgrading of the Embankment and creation of a new Entrance Plaza and Pedestrian Bridge. The Speedway Pits is due for completion October 2020 ahead of the new Speedway season. The exterior cladding replacement for Arenas 2 & 3 started May 2020 and is due for completion in the first half of FY20/21. The new ceiling, LED lighting, and fire safety upgrades within Arena 2 continued throughout the year.
- Streets for People Stage 2 Delay in completion of construction due to the Covid-19. however the contractor made changes to the overall programme which has seen the footpath open earlier than planned with positive impact for the retailers. Expected completion beginning August. The Events Team are working closely with retailers to make the most of the opportunities a "Grand Opening" will bring.
- Urban Eels Eel Feeding Platform completed.
- Albert Street Events Hard Stand Tini Whetu Kitirangi, has been completed.
- Held successful 2019 Spring Kohanga Bonfire Event.
- Ahimate Reserve Completion of new novice skills Mountain Bike area. Opened Ahimate Reserve to selfcontained campervans.

- Stonev Creek Road Intersection Improvement Project Complete.
  - Stage 1 of College Street Upgrade completed along with improvements in Awapuni Village.
  - Off Road Pathway repairs completed on Pioneer Highway Shared Path and Manawatu River Pathway.
- · Major pavement repairs and resurfacing completed for Mihaere/Keith Roundabout, Mihaere Drive. Tremaine/Railway/Vogel Street intersection & Tennent Drive.
- Construction of 892m of new footpaths Successful recruitment of Activity Manager – Transport and Active Transport.


