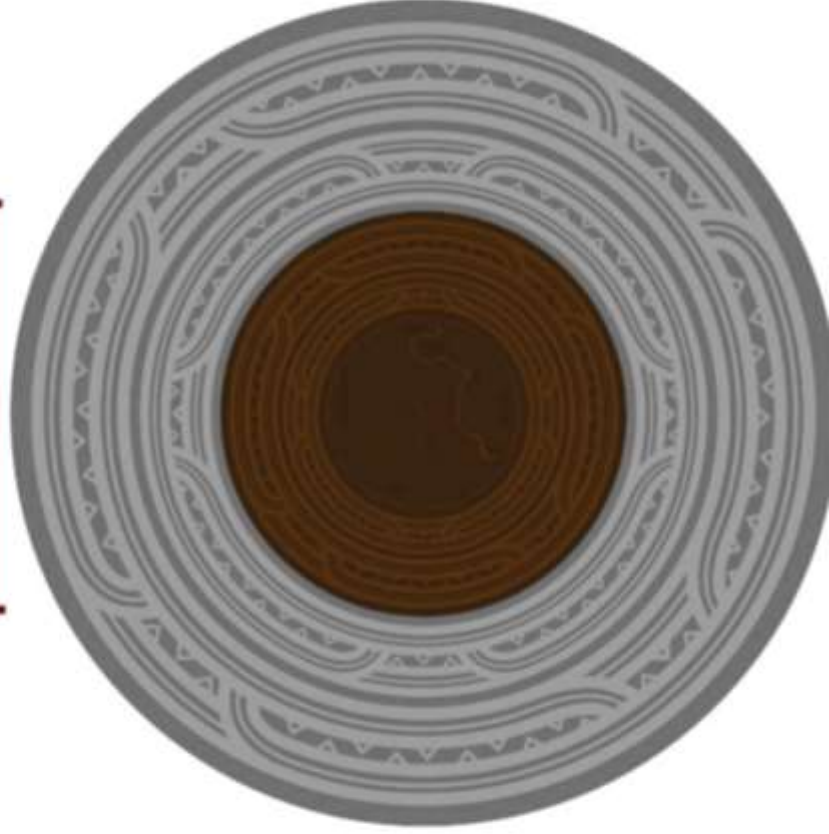

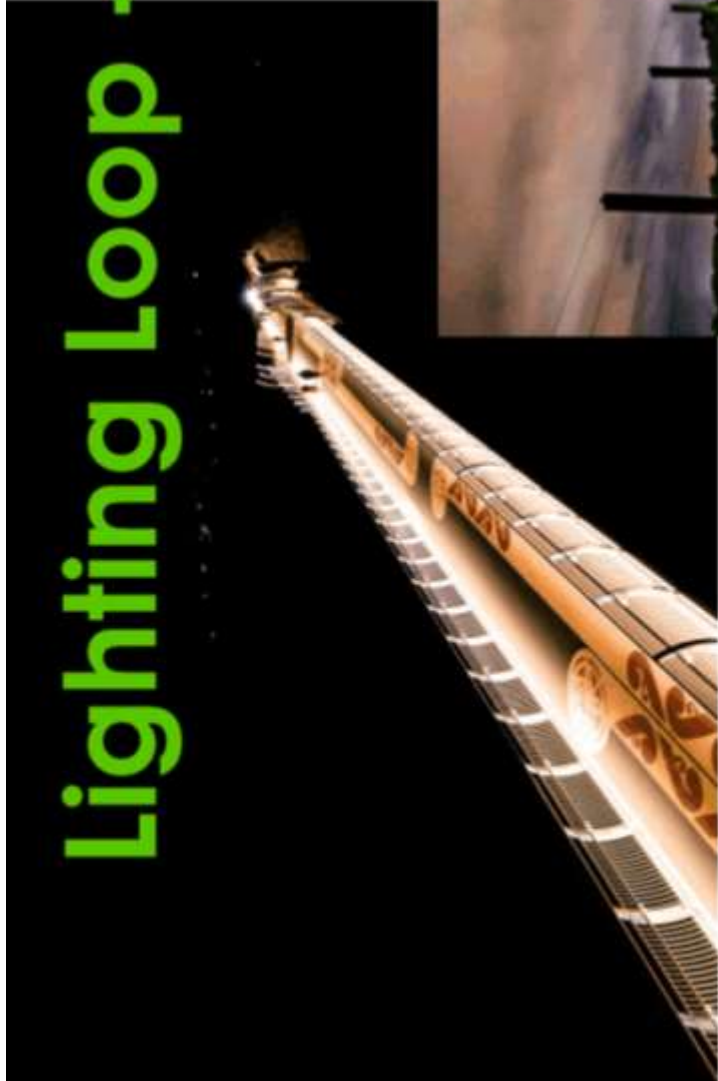

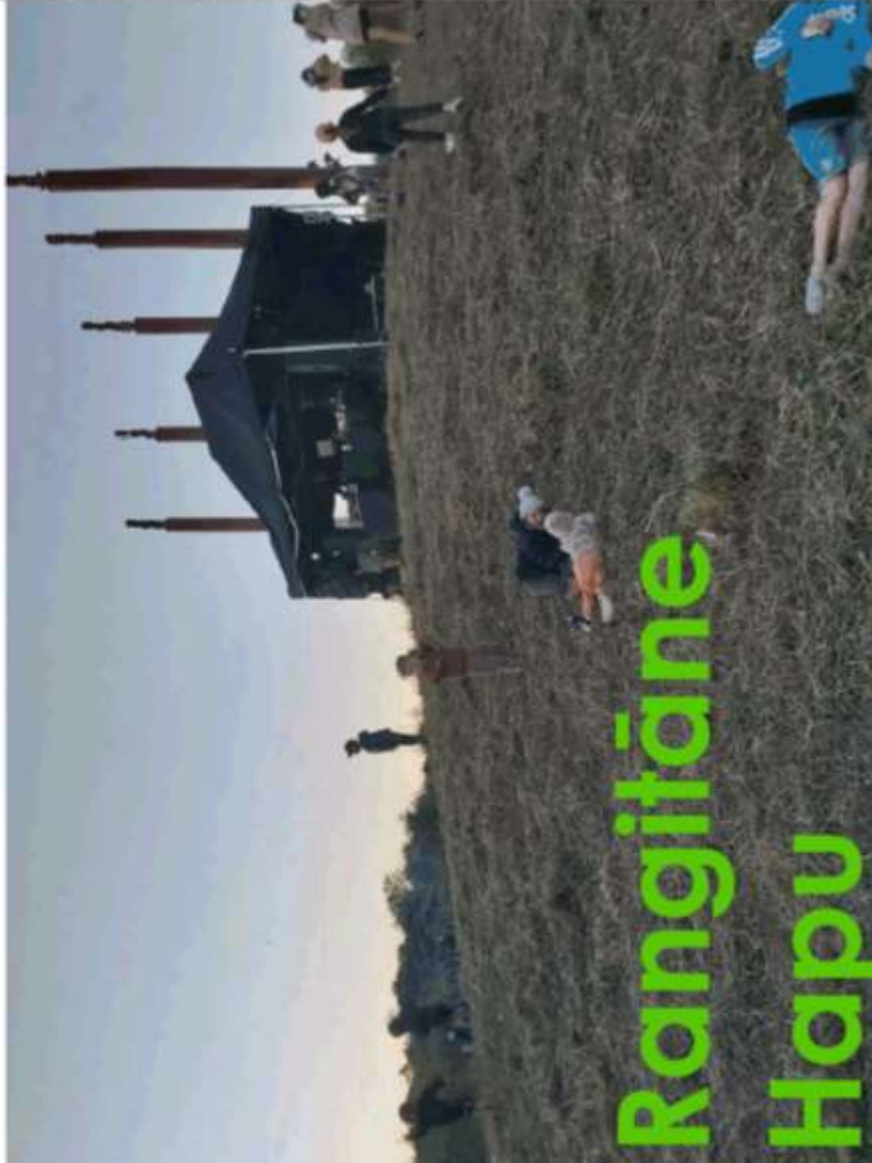

What's Happened?

- Committee and Kawenata
- Rangitāne Working Party established
- Rangitāne Committee – presentation on aspirations
- Early Co-Engagement
- Councillor workshop on aspirations and direction
- 1.7mil – 10 Year Plan (\$150,000 for design 21/22)

Co-design and co-engagement

- Established a Development Plan Team – Rangitāne, PNCC, Landscape Designers (Te Ao Māori Designer), Architect (tba)
- Developed a co-engagement process – how we engage legitimately and respect the cultural process or tikanga
- Site Constraints – Geotech, tikanga, geographical space, cultural landscape form
- Scope of works and procurement

What are the next steps?

- Procure an Architect – through to concept design (June to August 2021)
- Site constraints and concepts – Rangitāne to talk to their people (July 2021)
- Communications Plan (July 2021)
- Develop draft plan (August – December 2021)
- Consult with the Community on draft (March 2022)
- Develop a Partnership Funding and Phasing Plan (March – April) 2022)
- Final Te Motu O Poutoa Development Plan (May-June 2022)
- Budgets to Annual Plan (2023)
- Construction design (May – September 2022)
