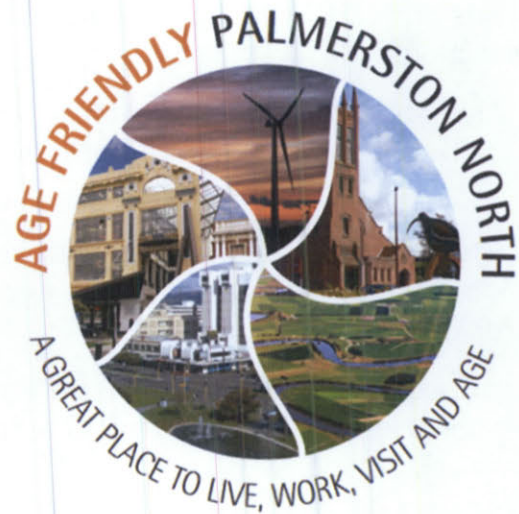

Age Friendly Palmerston North would like to acknowledge the Palmerston North City Council's support for the subsidised Gold Card parking for seniors between 9am -12 noon, Mondays to Fridays. The feedback from our senior community is that it has been very beneficial for them and is very much appreciated.

Age Friendly Palmerston North Submission:

We would like to suggest that this is now extended a further three hours to cover from 9am to 3pm Monday to Friday for these reasons:

1. The senior sector provides, a large proportion of volunteers who work in organisations throughout Palmerston North.

The extension of gold card concession parking in the CBD would make it easier for them to attend the facilities in which they do their volunteer work.

2. A large proportion of our older residents need community support services in their own homes for their daily care. This is usually provided in morning time slots. This disadvantages our seniors if they wish to use the amenities within the City.


3. The extension of the parking concession hours would let older people meet friends and family for lunch and shopping without the worry of parking restrictions

4. Many appointments for professional services e.g., dentist or doctor, are often made by the professional themselves, which means that 9am -12 parking concessions cannot be used.

5. We see it as essential that both central and local government encourages and supports an age friendly city and encourages older people to be active and participate in their community.

As an extension of this submission, we also ask that parking on Sundays remains free. We look forward to a positive outcome for this submission and await your response.
