Re. RIVER CROSSING in vicinity of STACES ROAD.

This matter should be reviewed IMMEDIATELY.

1. The current proposed Project was designed as part of a Highway Ring Road scheme which ignored Local Access requirements (and has been considered by P.N.C.C. to be unaffordable unless subsidized by Government Funding.)
2. The current Regional Transport Ring Road proposal does not have a river crossing in this vicinity, but will probably delete the existing project or further restrict Government Funding for it.
3. We need better access between the growing suburbs of Whakarongo and Aokautere. (A bridge for Pedestrians, Cyclists and Light Motor Vehicles would be appreciated.)
4. Walkways and other Recreational Schemes assume that there will ultimately be a crossing in this vicinity.
5. When P.N.C.C. postponed the commencement of this project (because of lack of funding) cheaper alternatives were not considered.
6. All subsequent reasoning seems to have been based on Traffic Densities for alternative main routes ignoring the need for Local Access..
7. Please also note that the proposed Te Araroa Pathway joins the Riverside Pathway just across the river from Staces Road.
