#### PNCC participation at the 2018 Sister Cities New Zealand Conference

This item seeks Council's approval for Councillors to take part in the upcoming Sister Cities New Zealand annual conference, to be held 24-26 May, Lower Hutt.

The theme of the 2018 Conference is "connecting globally through technology". This is a timely theme for Palmerston North to learn from best practice, as we work to introduce our own school-to-school skype connections with our Sister Cities.

The urgency of this item is to ensure that the relevant Councillors can register before the early bird date of 31 March.

As a SCNZ Local Government member, the early bird rate is \$600 (excl. GST), which includes the Awards dinner, or \$250 excluding the awards dinner. Full programme and registration information is attached to this report.

The proximity of the 2018 conference means that flights are not required, so it is affordable for more Councilors to participate this year than earlier conferences further afield (the suggestion is 4-5)
