Issue a couple of permits per household, allowing residents to park their vehicles on-street during the ban period. Then, work with manfield or the speedway to run regular track days where racing is free. Those track nights need to be regular enough to satiate the demand of racers and at a time of night equivalent to when they would normally be racing. The only requirement should be that racers provide their car rego and driver licence on entry. I live right near pioneer highway and see that street racing is constant and affects almost all Palmerston North. I not only see property being damaged, but outside being killed and people put in danger. It's a serious issue that requires a much more serious and wide ranging response than this proposal is able to deliver.

Can you tell us why?	The Manawatu Business Chamber represents our Members (the business community) across the wider Manawatu region. In recent months we have been involved with the City Council and Police with regards to the problems associated with 'street-racing' in the City. We have had numerous interactions with businesses who over the last year have complained about the actions of street-racers and the impact on their businesses, included significant levels of noise and disruption, along with damage to roads and property.
	We are aware that Council has also implemented traffic devices and engineering solutions on some roads in an attempt to lessen the problem and the amendment to the bylaw will go some way towards reducing the problem; specifically on the designated roads, with the option to add other roads if required.
	Our concern is that those who engage in the street-racing will simply move elsewhere, and possibly into even more public areas, and that the proposed restrictions won't address the real issue; which is too many, mostly young people, feeling as though they can congregate in the way they do in our city (and others). This is a nationwide issue, a central government issue, a local government issue and a community issue and we offer our support in looking at solutions to this issue going forward.
	We believe the amendment to the Traffic and Parking Bylaw does go some way to address the issue as a starting point and therefore we fully support the amendment as it stands.

They cause damage, pose a risk, are a nuisance and their activities damage the environment. They generate noise, toxic smoke and they leave the filth they make behind. Generally speaking street racers do not take responsability for the impacts of their behaviour, they act without concern for the welbeing of other people and their activities are unsafe for both themselves and others and the problem is growing because they have a high degree of imunity. The law appears to protect their rights while the street racers put their needs above those of other citizens who's lives are disturbed by their activities.	
Are there any changes you would make to the proposed amendments?	While I agree that the industrial area gatherings are a nuisance, I also propose that there needs to be a broader coverage to give police broader powers city-wide. Every year there are a number of incidents in the city that police say they are powerless to stop because of a lack of evidence. Getting evidence often means walking up to the activity and taking photos in front of groups of drunks. The police advise against doing this because it puts citizens at immediate risk of harm and can lead to further persecution from youths and gangs. Moreover, it's been my experience that smoke from burnouts hides registration plates and offenders. Making evidence very difficult to collect. I also watched the police walk over burned rubber on an offenders driveway at 2am one morning, claiming they did not have enough evidence that the youths at the party had done burnouts. 3 months later, there are still burnout marks on the road outside my home after the neighbours son and his friends spent the early hours doing burnouts and filling the air with filthy smoke. I propose amending the bylaw so that police are able to fine, arrest or impound vehicles of youths who deliberately put themselves, others and the environment at risk through their behaviour throughout the entire city. This behaviour is destructive and it affects the wellbeing of others in multiple ways so everything that can be done should be done to stop it.	
Do you have any other feedback on this proposed bylaw amendment?	There are too many inconsistencies in how people are treated with respect to their right to live safe, peaceful lives. As citizens we are told to phone in our complaints about unreasonable activities in the community and to be persistent if it continues. In my experience even persistence doesn't alter policing and the policing often appears to support antisocial behaviour.	

Police callcentre operators tell us to get evidence of street racer activity, yet its almost impossible to get photographic evidence without placing ourselves in harms way. The amendments need to really protect people, not just be a band-aid.

It can take days to recover from the early morning impacts of street racer activities in my community. Last summer it was happening 2 nights a week, 3 on a long weekend. This affects the everyday lives of ordinary people who feel the law should protect their peaceful enjoyment of life and want to live in a safer community.

Police action seems to have had an impact. I see and hear fewer cars which look and sound obviously unroadworthy; the really dodgy ones seem to disappear soon after I report them. I still see and hear 'boy racer' type cars, but they don't seem to congregate in my neighbourhood any more. It seems like Police are doing all they can with their current powers, and the only thing that will improve the situation is if those powers are increased. Whether walking, driving my car or riding my ebike, I do not like sharing the road and the neighbourhood with people who treat public roads as their own personal race track, and driving as a sport and a competition. This proposed new clause in the Traffic and Parking Bylaw seems to me to reinforce the idea that our roads are a public place, and should be able to be used safely by everybody to get from A to B.

Seacrest Properties Limited owns the property at 60 Bennett Street (right across the end of the cul-de-sac and heavy traffic to and from this site will be be among the most effected by the proposal. The creation of a central island of speed bumps in the cul de sac is unlikely to prevent burn-outs from occurring around its perimeter. In-fact, the presence of the central island will effectively form a 'drifting' track around it's perimeter - probably more of an attraction than a deterrent. 	
Are there any changes you would make to the proposed amendments?	I fully acknowledge the problem and seek to eliminate it from Bennett Street. However, I believe this proposal creates far greater problems to the legitimate users of Bennett Street than does the problem which needs to be solved. In this day and age I would expect current digital technology in the form of surveillance, traffic management and policing be applied to this issue rather than the 1970's technology offered by this proposal. Additionally, the location of the Mangaone Street could also provide a sufficient non-potable water supply which could be reticulated to each street light standard and then up the inside of each standard to high-volume spray nozzles located adjacent to each street-light fitting. The non-potable water supply could be activated remotely to create intensive sprays of water (heavy rain equivalent) along the entire length of the street once digital surveillance indicated the presence of any 'racers'. After having fulfilled its function by temporarily ruining the venue for the purpose of the offenders and their spectators, the 'rain' created will simply return to the Mangaone Stream via the existing storm-water system and life will return to normal for the legimate users of Bennett Street. The use of remotely controlled 'rise-and-fall' bollards to block Bennett Street at the Benmore Avenue intersection is another technology option that might be worth exploring.

It aims to prevent crime before it happens, ultimately making New Zealand a safer and better place to live, work and visit. This model supports the Palmerston North City Council's goal, to have a safe community, which is an attractive place to live, work and visit. Prevention First is designed to support and enhance the delivery of Police key goals: Prevent crime and victimisation Target and catch offenders Deliver a more responsive Police service It puts all people – victims, offenders and community at the centre of everything Police do through: Deploying to beat demand Targeting the drivers of police demand (Alcohol, Youth/Rangatahi, Families/Whānau, Roads, Organised crime and drugs, Mental health) Having the right mind-set: taking every opportunity to prevent harm. These three components are supported through meaningful partnerships with others in the community. Prevention First emphasises the need for Police to engage effectively with their partners. Manawatu Police believe the Palmerston North City Council is a key partner in preventing crime. Police submit: Restricting vehicular traffic through by-law creation referencing specific locations and time periods will minimise harm within our community. Anti-Social Vehicle Users (ASVU) who congregate in numbers then cruise Palmerston North City and outer townships to meet up at pre-determined sites to do 'burnouts' have become a major public nuisance. Their driving is a risk to themselves and other road users as well as bystanders.

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- Commercial operators in industrial areas are significantly impacted with road access to their businesses blocked, drivers being threatened and damage to infrastructure.
- Residents are tormented with the constant roar of engines and the screeching of tyres which is making it impossible to sleep.
- These events now occur almost every weekend. The numbers of participants and onlookers is regularly between 50 and 100 cars a night.
- The Police have, on a number of occasions, tried to enter the area and disrupt the behaviour of the drivers, however the numbers are so vast that as the Police enter the road, pedestrians will walk out, block the Police vehicle access, surround the car and then essentially force the Police to make the decision to leave the site.
- Police believe it is only a matter of time before one of the participants or onlookers are seriously injured or killed as recently as (12 February 2022) occurred at Works Road, Longburn. Person 'struck by vehicle', another stabbed and officer attacked and knocked to ground near Palmerston North | Stuff.co.nz

Police have collaborated with Palmerston North City Council, other key partners including Business owners focusing on a number of environmental prevention strategies and enforcement activities at locations around the city in an attempt to disrupt this driver behaviour over the last 18 months.

Police contend that this persistent behaviour is not just a Police problem, it requires a collaborative joined up approach across multiple stakeholders to achieve a sustainable outcome that supports the well-being of residents and business owners.

Police appreciate that engineering solutions require capital investment and accept that the City Council may not be able to sustain that, therefore other tactics should be considered alongside these measures.

Crime Science and experience has shown that enforcement activity will only temporarily reduce offending and displacement will occur. After a period of time the Anti-Social Vehicle Users will look for new areas and sites to conduct their burnouts and illegal street races.

A balanced prevention and enforcement approach will provide a more durable outcome and will provide a sustainable solution in terms of cost and resource deployment.

In considering other districts around New Zealand, the Police have identified some success with the Hamilton City Council and the New Plymouth District Council where they have instigated bylaws targeting motor vehicle racing and Anti-Social Vehicle Use on public roads enabling police to issue infringement notices to vehicles congregating at specific locations in contravention of the regulations established through the bylaw.

The bylaws effectively provide Police with the ability to more safely disrupt

I propose that instead of installing expensive speed humps as deterrents, that the reflective 'cats eyes' used to mark centre lines be placed across the street in place where a speed bump would be useful. I know that this has been tried by members of the public in other cities and has had the positive results of vehicles slowing down close to them and in some cases simply avoiding the street entirely. I find the speed and noise tends to be an issue more in the weekends but it can happen on any day or night when one or two vehicles decide to loop around these side streets, often causing their cars to be extremely loud or they make their vehicles backfire constantly, all around the side streets, for half an hour or more before moving to a different set of side streets. I believe the 'cats eyes' placed across the street would definitely reduce the speed and the noise that comes with speed.
Do you have any other feedback on this proposed bylaw amendment?	It's not just the specified areas that are having trouble with congregations of vehicles, as the sound travels a long distance. I can often hear cats racing on the double lane roads such as Main Street, Fitzherbert Avenue, Rangitikei Street and Pioneer Highway. The speed is very concerning, but the noise, while very loud, does pass quickly. The biggest issue is vehicles, especially those with louder exhaust systems, are using the side streets to speed up and slow down again and again and again, so something is definitely needed as something a little bit too annoying to encourage those to discontinue the behaviour.


