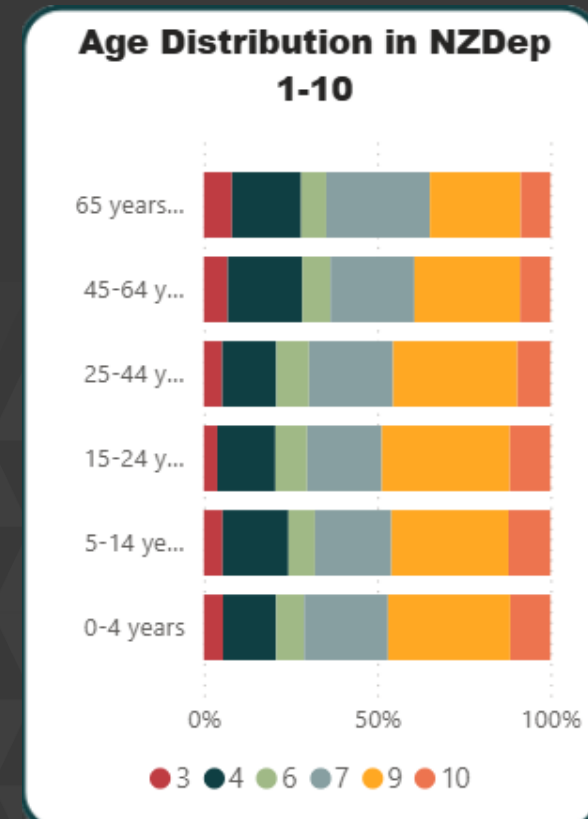
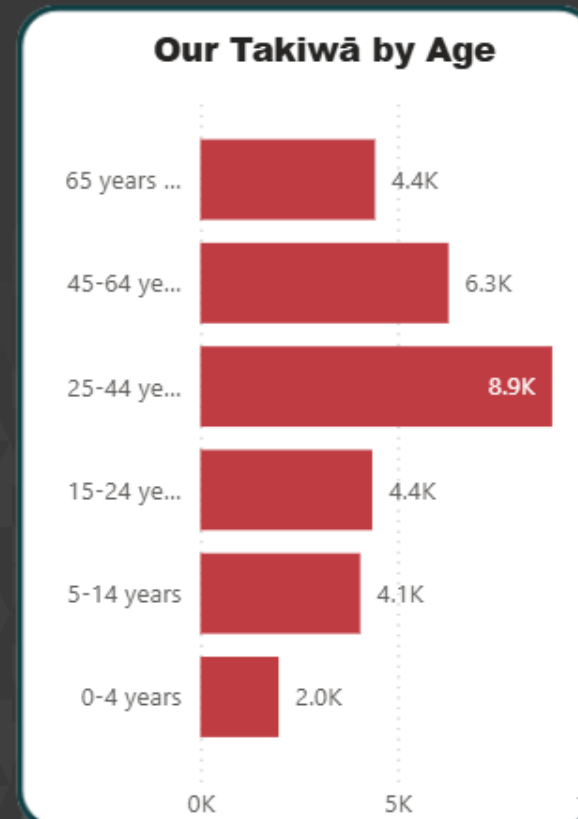
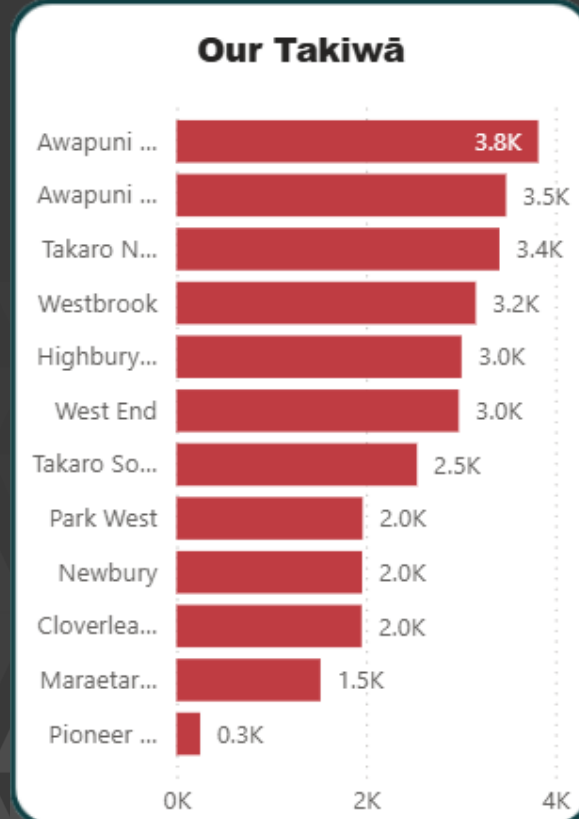
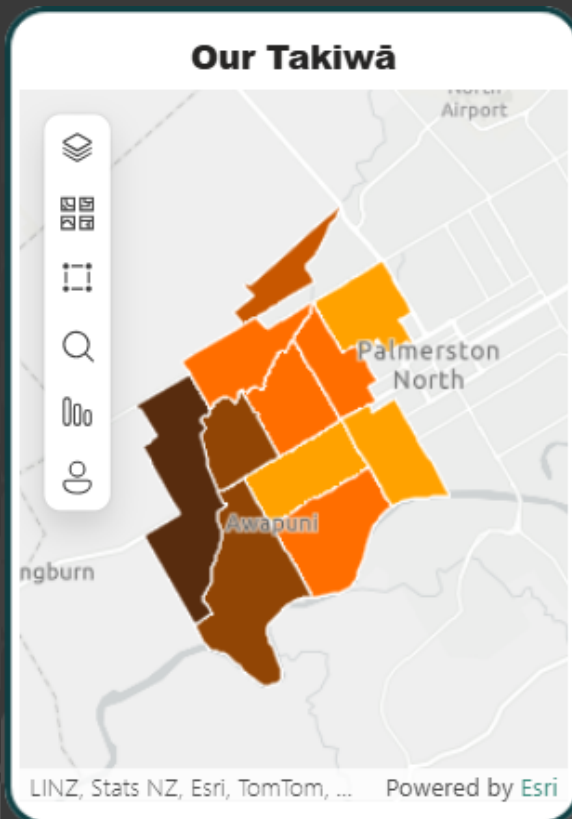
ORA KONNECT
