

Raised boardwalks, footpaths and teaching platforms feature in this zone







TE ARA RANGANUI: THE FOREST ZONE











HE MARA PAPATŪĀNUKU



THE ARBORETUM ZONE


















The garden concept has been broken into seven achievable 'zones' to be completed in stages.

The filtration zone will be the first zone completed.

- QS for this zone has been kept to an achievable \$10 mil
- The Foundation will need to endow an additional \$2.4 million for the annual operational costs of the garden
- Fundraising target for stage 1, the Filtration Zone, is therefore \$12.4 million

What would we like from PNCC now...

On 20 March the University launched the For A Better World campaign...

- The campaign seeks to raise \$32 million in the next three years to support areas at Massey where the university has strength, where there is a need for graduates, and where we want to remain world leaders that is broadly the food and fibre sector, design and public health.
- The campaign will also fundraise to support stage one of Te Waimana O
 Turitea to showcase Massey's areas of excellence and to form a literal
 gateway into study in these key sectors
- We'd like PNCC to make a pledge of \$1 million (over three years) to the Te Waimana O Turitea Project that will allow us to approach Lotteries and other rs that require evidence of other funders
